2. Call To Order & Those Present

Commissioner Morris, Commissioner DeGroot, Commissioner Boyd, Sandy Cox/Admin Staff, Marc Henderson/Counsel, Deputy Justman, Vickie Noel/Finance

3. Approve Minutes From Last Meeting

Commissioner Morris approves minutes from last Work Session meeting

4. Marc Kane, Senior Center - Renovation

Marc Kane addresses the Board provides updates of the Center. Further is requesting approval to remodel the bathrooms, presents plans, as the building is owned by the County, Board is good with renovation. Kane further indicates that they are applying for a grant through the County's ARP program, is seeking exception to have the permits prior to construction as that is what the application requires. Commissioner DeGroot is good with the exception. Commissioner Boyd doesn't believe the County should require permits just to apply, so he good with that too. Additionally Kane asks for permit fee waiver, Commissioner DeGroot indicates he needs to go through the process for that waiver. Last, Kane requests funding from the County to participate in this project. Board consensus is for Kane to apply for funding through the ARP grant process and see what happens, if there is still a need for funding after that then the Board will consider a funding request.

5. Livestock Hearing - Rojas Vs Delaney

Commissioner Morris opens hearing, questions Board if any conflicts to declare? None

Deputy Justman addresses the Board, presents details of incident. Board clarifies two different incidents included in the one hearing. Justman explains yes, the previous incident they did not locate the dogs or have owner information to have a hearing

Areli Rojas, sworn gives testimony, indicates 8 chickens died one survived. Has concerns about the dogs coming back and presenting a danger to her kids.

Carla Delaney, sworn, gives testimony dogs accidentally got out, apologizes for incident. Would like to get dogs back.

Commissioner Morris closes hearing to open for Board deliberation.

Commissioner DeGroot explains the law is very clear and explains if this happens again the Board will have no choice but to euthanize the dogs.

Commissioner Boyd reviews the civil penalty range 500-1000 per dog and indicates Animal Control is recommending the minimum amount to be fair.

Commissioner DeGroot motions to impose the fees as recommended by Animal Control minus 25 for a chicken that lived and sign affidavit to keep dogs contained, total of \$1760.00, Commissioner Morris seconds.

Unanimous vote, Approved.
