4. Nathan Bigby - Assessor

1. GIS - Request For Facebook Page

1. Supervision Fees

Aaron Hartman addresses the Board, explains SB620 which eliminates supervision fees, explains the challenges and fiscal impact, with the approved "backfill" funding they will be about 100k short for this biennium. Just wanted to keep the Board apprised.

Erik Nobel addresses the Board gives background regarding Ordinance 45.96. Commissioner Boyd is the one that asked for this review, believes there was a piece missed when this Ordinance was passed, thinks we need to allow a 6 month storage permit to allow citizens to move through the process. Discussion about sending this back through the Planning Commission for reconsideration. Commissioner Boyd states we have an individual right now that is out of compliance right now and cant get through the process quickly. Nobel responds and explains this particular individual has not even started the permitting process yet, this has been explained to him over the last couple years. Commissioner DeGroot thinks we should send back through the Planning Commission explaining the current problem and see if they even recommend a change. Commissioner Morris asks if Nobel can bring this issue to the Planning Commission at their September meeting? Nobel will add to the agenda.
