- **Conduct a Service Inventory and Assessment:** Assess the efficiency, effectiveness, and alignment of existing services across different agencies and jurisdictions. Identify any duplication, gaps, or areas where coordination can enhance service delivery.
- **Facilitate Interagency Communication and Collaboration:** Foster regular communication channels and collaborative mechanisms among service providers within Klamath County. Establish interagency working groups, task forces, or committees to address common issues, share best practices, and streamline processes. Organize regular meetings, workshops, or forums to promote information exchange, brainstorm solutions, and align strategies.
- **Identify Service Integration Opportunities:** Evaluate opportunities for integrating or consolidating specific services to improve efficiency and effectiveness. Identify services that can be shared or coordinated among different agencies or jurisdictions. Explore potential partnerships or contractual arrangements to deliver services more efficiently.
- **Develop Joint Service Agreements:** Establish formal agreements among service providers to outline shared goals, responsibilities, and resource allocation. Define performance metrics and service standards to ensure accountability and quality of service provision. Regularly review and evaluate joint service
