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Hi Eric,

I have not had time to study the Oregon land use. I will be prepared for the Oct. 26th meeting. I suppose the letter I received means we have possible land around green acres that would be suitable for solar panels.

Such as class 4 soil.

Our lands, farm lands & range land have soil class 4 or better, but more importantly the quality even though class 4 is recognized as good soil for farming. Many of our adjacent lands are farmed as proof, and are farmed even during the severest drought conditions, for we have the aquifer to support farming.

Green Acres, as you know will do what ever is necessary to stop any development of their surrounding graze and farm lands to be developed into solar panels.

Just because you are protecting soils 1,2,3, does not mean the state will not have a say within the UGB about the development of a soil class of 4. Which is highly regarded by the state.

Green Acres has been through these fights before, when it comes to converting soil producing land into something other than what is allowed for use upon that land within the UGB.

So if anyone proposal a site development of solar panels within our immediate area, you should let them know that Green Acres will put up a substantial fight.
